Programs

<u>The Spirit of the Canyons</u>

Daily at 8:15am returning 11:30am-12:30pm

Explore the classic winter scenery in the Bow Valley and the rock and ice sculptures of our mountain canyons. The drive to the canyon explores the ecological heart of Banff National Park, as you pass through the effects of forest fires and come to appreciate the way vegetation and wildlife interact with the landscape. In the canyon, you are surrounded by the wonder of water in winter. Sense the magic, and come to feel why native people felt these places to be sites of power and spirituality.

In the spring and fall, or when the snow is shallow, this event will be a hike. Snowshoes or not, we will take you to a special part of the landscape for a very memorable afternoon.

Snowshoeing

Daily at 1:00pm returning 3:30pm - 4:30pm

No skill required! Whether it's up in the high country along the Great Divide, or reading the tracks of wildlife along the Bow River Valley, this is everyone's way to walk into a mountain winter. Let one of our guides lead you into the silence of winter, surrounded by alpine scenery and tales of Canadian mountain men and women.

Star Gazing By Request

On a clear night you can see 2.4 million light years away! Step outside to explore the night sky and discover the jewels of the Pleiades star cluster, the magical rings of Saturn and explore constellations such as Orion where you can see new stars being born.

Grotto Canyon Icewalk - Available upon request to fit your schedule!

An exciting adventure into winter wilderness.

The walk through Grotto Canyon offers the visitor an exciting opportunity to walk along the bottom of an ice covered canyon floor. As the walk progresses, the walls of the canyon close in, and become ever steeper and higher. Just when it looks like the canyon has ended at two dramatic frozen waterfalls, it takes a sharp turn to the left and continues. And then just as suddenly the canyon ends and opens up into a "Lost Valley" whose only entrance or exit is the path you've just taken! This dramatic finish in an almost inaccessible mountain valley and the "Hermit's Hideout" will leave you with a taste of what real wilderness is all about!
