Dear Course Participant,

Aloha and a warm welcome from your Landmark Vacation Course, Transforming Yesterday's Strategies, at the Hapuna Beach Prince Hotel on the Big Island of Hawaii, August 4 -10, 2010! Enclosed in the travel document folder are your hotel confirmation, course sticker, luggage tags, and some general information about your stay. Please read this information prior to your trip.

Packing Instructions and Attire

The dress code in Hawaii is casual. Shorts are acceptable for men and women practically everywhere. Some of the more upscale restaurants require men to wear a shirt and trousers but never a tie. Women also have the option of wearing dresses.

Activities on the Big Island range from horseback riding to snorkeling, so pack for outdoor activities as well as for comfort in the course room. The average daytime temperature in August ranges from 75 to 85 degrees Fahrenheit, with moderate humidity. Bring your swimwear and sunblock for the pool and beach.

Airline Check-in and Baggage

Please take a moment to review your enclosed itinerary, and make note of the airline, departure date and flight times. If you notice a discrepancy, please contact A Cruise World or the travel agent that made your reservation right away. **Please reconfirm your flight information 24 hours before your departure.**

Plan to arrive at the airport at least two hours prior to the departure of your flight. If your flights are delayed getting to Hawaii, please call A Cruise World at (800) 442-9278 or (626) 449-2811, and we will let your course leader know when to expect you. You can also leave a message for John Severson at the Hapuna Beach Prince Hotel at (808) 880-1111.

Ground Transportation

Once you arrive at the Kona International Airport, please proceed to the baggage claim area, where you will be met by our airport greeters. Look for their "Aloha Landmark Education" signs. It will be helpful to them for you to wear your "Transforming Yesterday's Strategies" sticker. If for any reason our greeters don't find you, please have the information desk, which is also located in the baggage claim area, page an "Alii Lei Greeter", or call (808) 572-1160. Unless you are renting a car, you will be taken by shuttle to the hotel. Once you arrive at the Hapuna Beach Prince Hotel, please give your luggage to the bellhop, and then check in at the front desk.

If you are renting a car, please proceed to the rental car shuttle stop located across the street from baggage claim. Exit the airport and take highway 19 north until you reach mile marker 69. Look for the first right turn for the entrance to the Hapuna Beach Prince Hotel. Both valet and self parking fees has been waived for our group. Please inform the front desk that you have a car and that you are with the Landmark Education group.

Meals and Dining Credit

Included in your program are six breakfasts and four dinners. Breakfast each morning is served at the Ocean Terrace, and you are welcome to enjoy either a delicious buffet or order from the hotel's menu. Three of our dinners will be group events: a Wednesday night welcome dinner, a Thursday dinner outside of the hotel, and our farewell dinner on Monday night. You will also receive a dining credit of \$60 for your fourth dinner, which can be used at any time in the hotel. Any unused credit can be used toward other purchases in the hotel.

Phone Service

The phone number for the Hapuna Beach Prince Hotel is (808) 880-1111. The fax number is (808) 879-8763. The hotel charges \$.75 for local calls and \$1.00 for other calls, including toll-free and calling card numbers. We recommend that you use a calling card for your calls. Pay phones, with no access charges, are also readily available in the lobby area of the hotel.

If you sign up for the Prince Preferred program at www.princepreferred.com prior to your arrival, your local and toll-free telephone calls will be complimentary during your stay. Registration is free, and you can read more about the program at the website above.

Massages

Also included in your tuition is one 50-minute massage at the hotel. Please review your enclosed massage confirmation for accuracy. Additional information about the massage will be given to you at your first course session.

Hospitality Desk

The Landmark Education Hospitality Desk will be located on the Breezeway and will be staffed each day of your course.
