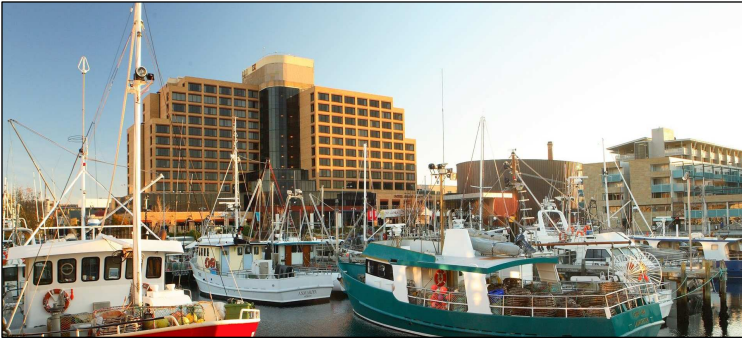

Passports

If you are holding an Australian passport, no visas will be required to enter Tasmania. For non-Australian citizens, a valid passport and possibly a visa may be required. Please check with your local consulate to see what restrictions may apply.

Arrival/Departure Time:

Please plan your flights to arrive by 1:00PM on March 5th so you can arrive at the Hotel Grand Chancellor by 3:00 PM, and have your flights depart after 1:00 PM on March 11th. Travel time between the airport and the hotel is approximately 20 minutes. Because of the short distance from Hobart, hired taxis can easily be found at the terminal. Air Travel:

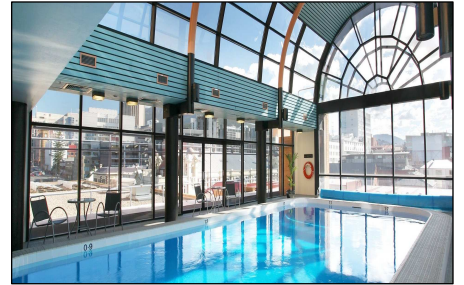
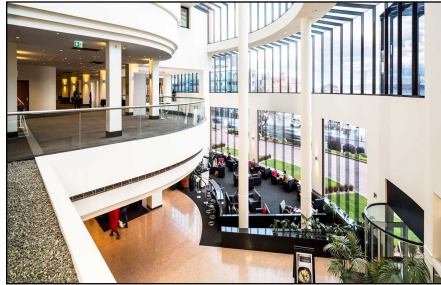
