

Dear Course Participant,

A warm welcome to your Landmark Vacation Course, Transforming Yesterday's Strategies, at the Eagle's Palace in Ouranoupolis, Greece September 23- September 29, 2017.

Passports

If you are holding a European Community passport, no visas will be required to enter Greece. For non-European citizens, a valid passport and possibly a visa may be required. I recommend that you reconfirm your flights to Thessaloniki (SKG) and seat assignments 24 hours before your departure.

What To Pack

The dress code in Greece is very casual; shorts are acceptable nearly everywhere. As it tends to get cooler at night, we suggest you wear a sweater, jacket, long sleeve shirt and/or long pants, especially if you're eating outdoors.

The average daytime temperature in September ranges from 20 to 25 degrees Celsius with moderate humidity. Bring your swimwear, sun block, hat, and sunglasses for the pool and the beach.

Baggage requirements vary by airline, so please check with your carrier before your trip. To make identifying your luggage easier, please put your name on each piece of luggage.

Getting to the Hotel

The Eagles Palace is located just 4 km before you reach the town of Ouranoupolis, Halkidiki Greece. If you are driving, please look for the hotel entrance on your right a few kilometers after you pass the town of Neo Roda. The trip from the Thessaloniki airport to the Eagles Palace is about 100 kilometers and will take approximately 90 minutes.

We will be arranging several group shuttle buses between the Thessaloniki airport and Eagles Palace on our arrival date of September 23rd and departure date of September 29th. Please make sure we have assigned you to the correct shuttle time based on your flight schedule. When exiting baggage claim at the airport, look for an Eagles Palace representative holding an Eagle's Palace sign who will escort you to either a sedan or minibus. If you do not see an Eagles Palace representative, please call the hotel front desk at +30 23770 31101.

Pre/Post Night Stays

If you are arriving earlier than September 23rd, you have two different options for accommodations. You can stay close to the Thessaloniki airport (hotels such as Athina Palace or the Hyatt Regency) and take their complementary shuttles to and from the airport. Then you can meet back at the airport on Saturday September 23rd and catch your assigned bus to the Eagles Palace. You also have the option of booking a night before and staying at the Eagles Palace.

Because we are organizing special group shuttles, if you miss your scheduled shuttle time (either a flight delay or flight change), we may not be able to arrange a later shuttle pickup. Taxis will be available for hire for any services outside our arranged times (before September 23rd and beyond September 29th) at our special rate of 150 euros each way to and from the hotel.

Arriving at the Eagle's Palace

When you arrive at the hotel, check in with the front desk and give your luggage to the bellman. Relax and take a seat. The front desk staff will check you in and give you an envelope that contains information about our course during the week.

Six breakfasts and six dinners are included as part of your course tuition. Beverages during the meals will be at your own expense. If you wish to charge other meals or excursions to your room folio, you may do so by signing the check with your name and room number.

First Course Session

The first course session is from 4:00 - 7:00 PM, on Saturday, September 23^{rd} in the Theodora Conference Center located one level below the lobby.

Massage and Spa

Included in your course tuition is one fifty-minute Swedish massage at the Eagle's Spa. Enjoy all the amenities of the spa (included as part of your treatment), including steam rooms, whirlpools showers, and a relaxation area. You will receive your massage appointment time when upon check-in. Changes in appointments can be made directly with the Spa upon your arrival.

Activities in Halkidiki, Greece

Activities in and around the region include a morning cruise to view the Mount Athos monasteries and other historical sites. These can be reserved at the concierge desk, located in the hotel lobby. At the first session, we will also go over tours and excursions that you may wish to participate in during the week.
