



Congratulations and a warm welcome to your Landmark Vacation Course, Structural Connections, at the White Stallion Ranch. Enclosed you will find some general information about your stay at the ranch, along with your spa confirmation sheet and luggage tags. Please review this information before your trip begins.

Course Schedule

Our first course session on Monday, October 29th, will be held from 3:00PM - 6:30PM in the Longhorn Room located in the Conference Room building. The course schedule for the entire week is enclosed. Your Tuition includes all meals, daily horseback riding (except Sunday), one massage, two riding lessons and evening entertainment.

Please plan your flights so that you arrive before 1:30pm on Monday October 29th, and depart after 1:30pm on Sunday November 4th.

Packing Instructions and Attire

Tucson and its surrounding areas are mostly sunny with temperatures in the high 70's to mid 80's during the day and 50's at night. A coat or a light jacket is recommended for the evenings. All restaurants and eating venues on the property are casual.

Hiking, swimming, and horseback riding are some of the activities available to you while at the ranch. Be sure to pack for outdoor activities and bring loose, casual clothing in which you would be comfortable lying on a carpet or doing very mild exercise during the course sessions. Please bring your STR bag with you.

Airline Check-in and Luggage

Take a moment to review your flight itinerary and make note of the airline, departure date, and flight times. If you notice a discrepancy, please contact A Cruise World or the travel agent who made your reservation. Because airlines make changes frequently, it is a good idea to reconfirm your flight information 24 hours before your departure. It is best to arrive at your departing airport at least 90 minutes prior to the departure of your flight. If you encounter a long delay getting to Tucson or to the ranch, please call the White Stallion Ranch at (520) 297-0252. We can advise you on alternate arrangements and let your course leader know when to expect you.

To make identifying and locating your luggage easier, please attach the luggage tag to each piece of checked luggage.

Ground Transportation

If you have already provided us with your flight information, we have arranged for your transportation from the Tucson Airport to the White Stallion Ranch. After arriving at Tucson International Airport and collecting your luggage, you will find a White Stallion staff person at the airport by the General Information booth who will assist you in getting to the shuttle. The shuttle service will leave hourly from the airport and will take approximately 40 minutes to reach the ranch. If you wish to rent a car for your stay we have arranged a discount with AVIS car rentals. Simply use AWD number D183172 when making your reservation.

When you arrive at the White Stallion Ranch, please check in at the front desk to receive your room key, a welcome packet for the course, and a confirmation of your spa appointment.

Riding Lessons

In addition to the daily horseback rides available at the ranch, we have included two horseback riding lessons during the week as part of your tuition. These lessons are designed to advance your riding skills and we encourage you to partake in these lessons as early in the week as you can. We will have a sign up sheet in back of the course room to schedule your lessons. Additional riding lessons can be scheduled for \$20.00 per session.

Massage Reservations

One 50-minute spa treatment is included in your course tuition. If you did not let us know your preferred massage time, we selected a time for you, which is listed on your Spa Confirmation Sheet located in your welcome packet. Due to high volume, there are limited alternate massage times. If your spa appointment is not convenient for you, please contact us as soon as possible.

Other Activities In Tucson

Tucson, the second largest city in Arizona, offers a fascinating history of Spanish, Mexican, American and Confederate influences. Cultural offerings include the Tucson Symphony, the Arizona Theater Company, the Arizona Opera Company, and the Arizona Ballet Company. Museums include the Tucson Museum of Art, the Flandru Science and Planetarium, the Center for Creative Photography, the Arizona State Museum, the PIMA Air and Space Museum, the International Wildlife Museum, and the Arizona Sonora Desert Museum. The unique Arizona desert is also host to the beautiful Saguaro National Park.
