TRAVEL INFORMATION

Please plan your flights to arrive into Thessaloniki no later than 1:00 PM on September 23 and depart no earlier than 1:00 PM on September 29. Travel time between the airport and the hotel is approximately 90 minutes. Because of the long distance from Thessaloniki, hired taxis normally cost 150 euros each way and can hold up to three people.

As an added service, group round-trip transportation from the Thessaloniki International Airport to the Eagles Palace Hotel & Spa is available on a limited basis, September 23 and September 29, 2017. A mini bus from the hotel will be used to pick up participants on those days. If you wish to take advantage of this included service, please provide us with your flight information no later than August 15, 2017. If you plan on extending your stay additional nights before or after the course dates, please factor in the cost of taxi transportation in addition to the nightly room charge (see rates on our travel registratin page).

PRE/POST NIGHT STAYS
